Affected Facility	Fiberglass Systems, L.P. - Ridgefield 5985 S 6th Way, Ridgefield, WA 98642	
Description of Facility	This facility is a manufacturer of fiberglass reinforced products, such as pipes, boxes, and tanks, and fiberglass boats. Most production is performed using closed mold techniques, a filament winding machine, in addition to some hand and spray lay-up of fiberglass resins and gel coats.	
Source Designation	<u>Title V</u> The facility is a stationary source subject to the Operating Permit Program contained in Chapter 173-401 WAC. Facility emissions are greater than 10 tpy of any single hazardous air pollutant (styrene), and/or greater than 25 tpy of any combination of hazardous air pollutants.	
Purpose of Application	SWCAA has received a permit application for installation and operation of a natural gas-fired air handling unit at the above-described facility. The application has not yet been reviewed to determine if it is administratively complete. The SWCAA permit writer identified below will be reviewing the application to make a determination of completeness and, if necessary, make a request for additional information. A copy of the application will be available to the public when the application is determined to be complete.
