Description of Facility	Vancouver Bulk Terminal proposes to redevelop an existing bulk export facility into a soda ash export terminal. The proposed facility will receive natural soda ash by rail and store it onsite in flat storage. Soda ash will be loaded onto ocean-going marine vessels for export.		
Source Designation	Minor. The facility is a stationary source subject to review under SWCAA 400-110. Facility emissions will be less than 100 tpy of any single criteria pollutant, less than 10 tpy of any single hazardous air pollutant, and less than 25 tpy of any combination of hazardous air pollutants.		
Purpose of Application	SWCAA has received a permit application for installation of a soda ash export terminal at the above described facility.
