Affected Facility	Lonza – Arch Wood Protection 532 Hendrickson Drive Kalama, WA 98625
Description of Facility	Arch Wood Protection produces wood preservatives by blending raw materials in an agitated vessel, mix tanks, or in tanker trucks. Wood preservatives are also stored and transloaded at the facility. Emissions for some activities are controlled by a venturi/packed tower scrubbing system.
Source Designation	Natural Minor The facility is a stationary source subject to review under SWCAA 400-110. Facility emissions are less than 100 tons per year (tpy) of any single criteria pollutant, less than 10 tpy of any single hazardous air pollutant, and less than 25 tpy of any combination of hazardous air pollutants.
Purpose of Application	SWCAA has received a permit application requesting approval to produce additional chemical products. The application has not yet been reviewed to determine if it is administratively complete. The SWCAA permit writer identified below will be reviewing the application to make a determination of completeness and, if necessary, make a request for additional information.
