The Port proposes to install and operate a grain terminal facility on 2.1 acres of land located in Lewis County. The terminal will receive grain products from local farms via truck and rail. Grain products will be stored onsite in silos before being shipped off-site via truck and rail.		
Source Designation	Natural Minor. The facility is a stationary source subject to review under SWCAA 400-110.
