Action:	SWCAA is issuing a draft Air Operating Permit (AOP) for Cardinal FG – Winlock. The draft AOP is a renewal permit and incorporates applicable requirements from Local, State and Federal regulations.
Facility Description:	Cardinal FG – Winlock is a flat glass manufacturing plant located in Winlock, Washington. The manufacturing plant is designed around a single natural gas fired glass furnace and associated glass processing equipment. The facility owned by Cardinal FG Company and has a nominal glass production capacity of 750 tons per day (tpd). The glass furnace commenced operation in September 2006. The facility has the following emission units/activities: • Glass Furnace / Annealing Lehr • Glass Cutting Operations • Cullet Return System #1 • Cullet Return System #2 • EP Dust Baghouse #1 • EP Dust Baghouse #1 • Emergency Generator #1 • Emergency Generator #2 • Misc.
