DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) – SWCAA 24-026**

Description of proposal:

ADP Application CL-3267: The proponent has requested that their existing Air Discharge Permit be amended to remove older engines not subject to review and reclassify certain engines as nonroad. No physical changes are proposed. These changes remove operating restrictions for the affected engines but are not expected to result in an actual change in use or emissions to the atmosphere. At the emission levels proposed, this equipment does not have a significant adverse impact on ambient air quality. This permitting action is not expected to have any effect on traffic, noise, glare, housing, or recreation opportunities.
