**DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) – SWCAA 24-027**

**Description of proposal:**

ADP Application L-744: Increase in approved material throughput to allow production of a maximum of 500 vehicles per year. Applicant proposes to increase production throughput without making any physical changes to existing operations. The proposed increase in production will not require any excavation or building construction. Facility impact on media other than air (traffic, light, noise, water, etc.) is not expected to change. Air emissions will be minimized by the use of pollution control measures representative of Best Available Control Technology.
