DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) – SWCAA 24-028

Description of proposal:

ADP Application CO-1097: Installation of an aluminum die-casting and powder coating facility. The facility is configured with five electric melting furnaces and uses only aluminum ingots and clean scrap as feedstock. The proposed facility will be located in existing industrial buildings. The project does not include any building construction or excavation. General facility impact is consistent with current zoning and surrounding properties. Impact on air will be minimized through the use of process enclosure and emission controls.
