DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) - SWCAA 24-039

Description of proposal:

Heidelberg Materials submitted Air Discharge Permit (ADP) application CL-3280 to the Southwest Clean Air Agency to approve a rental rock crushing unit. At the emission levels proposed, this equipment will not have a significant adverse impact on ambient air quality.
