**DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) – SWCAA 24-042**

**Description of proposal:**

ADP Application L-748: Installation of nine diesel engine driven generators at an existing food storage and distribution warehouse. The proposed generators will be used to provide electric power to facility equipment during interruptions in utility power. The proposed project is limited to generator installation and does not include any modification or expansion of existing structures or infrastructure. Existing impact on elements such as traffic, light, noise, water, etc. is expected to continue unchanged. Impact on air will be minimized through the use of ultra-low sulfur fuel and by limitations on operation.
