DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE 25-002**

**Description of proposal:**

Wallace Brothers Inc. submitted Air Discharge Permit (ADP) application CL-3230 to the Southwest Clean Air Agency in which the facility is seeking approval to install and operate aggregate crushing and handling equipment along with nonroad diesel engines.

The ADP application was required as part of an enforcement action since this is an existing facility that was not previously permitted when it was constructed. Wallace Brothers operates an aggregate handling operation that primarily processes rock mined on site and reclaimed aggregate.
