DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) – SWCAA 25-006

Description of proposal:

ADP Application CO-1111: Operation of a portable rock crushing operation consisting of multiple rock crushers and aggregate screens, a diesel engine driven generator, and associated material transfer equipment. The rock crushing operation will primarily operate in rock pits and quarries. Operation of the proposed crushing equipment will not involve the construction of any structures or roads. Impact on air will be minimized through the use of wet suppression. Impact on other media (traffic, light, noise, water, etc.) is expected to be minimal and of a temporary nature.
