

State Environmental Policy Act DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE 25-012

Description of proposal:

Novolex Bagcraft submitted Air Discharge Permit (ADP) application CL-3287 to the Southwest Clean Air Agency in which the facility is seeking approval to install and operate one new Garant bag machine with an inline Garant flexographic printer. Novolex Bagcraft processes paper (rewinding, slitting, sheeting, embossing, etc.) and prints onto paper products. The new equipment will produce a small amount of emissions of volatile organic compounds and toxic air pollutants. At the emission levels proposed, this equipment will not have a significant adverse impact on ambient air quality. This permitting action is not expected to have any effect on traffic, noise, glare, housing, or recreation opportunities.
