Description of proposal:

ADP Application CL-3292: The proponent has requested approval to replace a crematorium that was destroyed by fire. The new crematorium has a greater operating capacity than the one it replaces; therefore, potential emissions may increase. Based on a review of the potential emissions increase, emissions from the replacement unit will not cause a significant adverse impact on ambient air quality. All reconstruction will be within the footprint of the pre-existing building; therefore, this permitting action is not expected to have a significant impact on any other element of the environment.
