DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) – SWCAA 25-021

Description of proposal:

ADP Application CO-1115: Proponent proposes to install a metal products manufacturing facility to produce bandsaw blades, machine knives, circular saw blades, and handsaws. The facility performs laser cutting, milling and grinding, abrasive blasting, and heat treatment of various metal parts. Operation of the facility will not have a significant adverse impact on ambient air quality at the levels proposed. This permitting action is not expected to have a significant adverse impact on any other element of the environment, including traffic, noise, glare, housing, or recreation opportunities. Proposed operations are consistent with the current use of surrounding properties.
