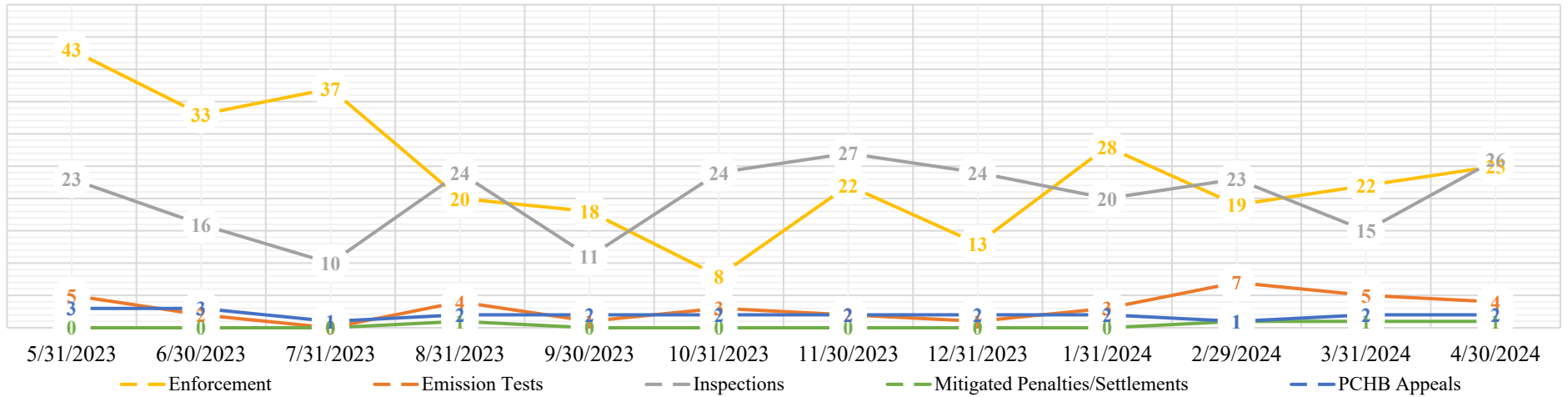

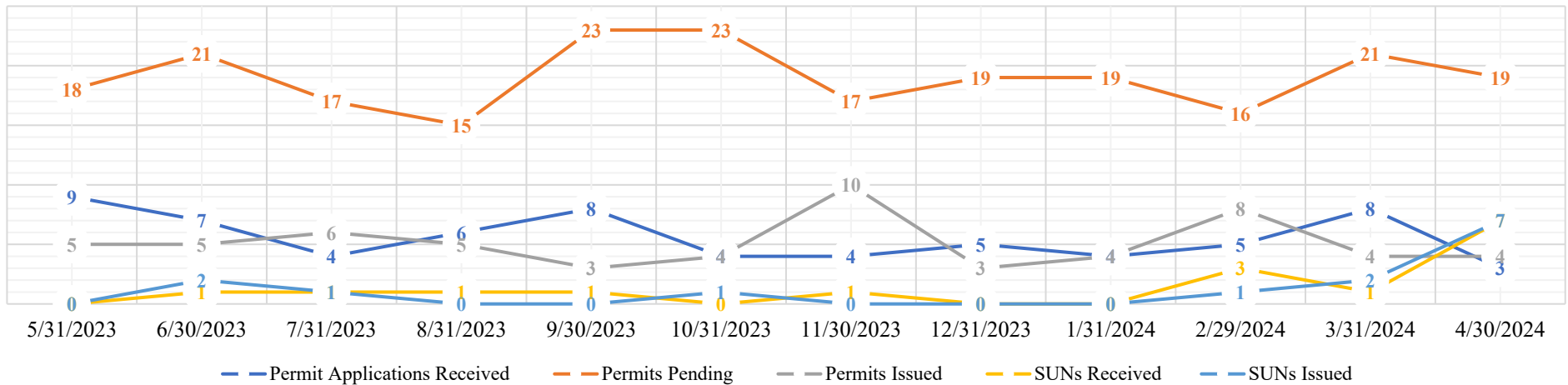

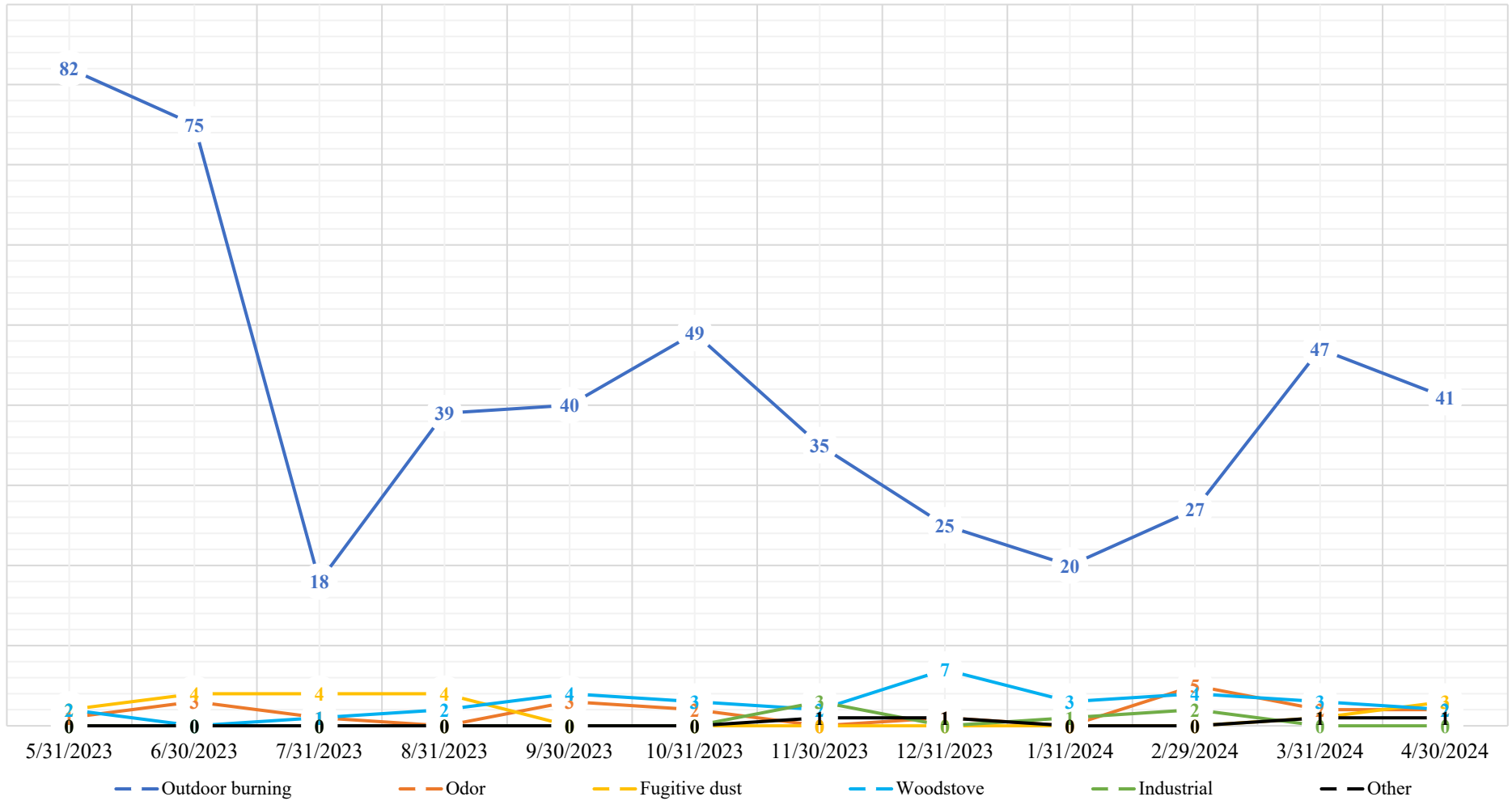

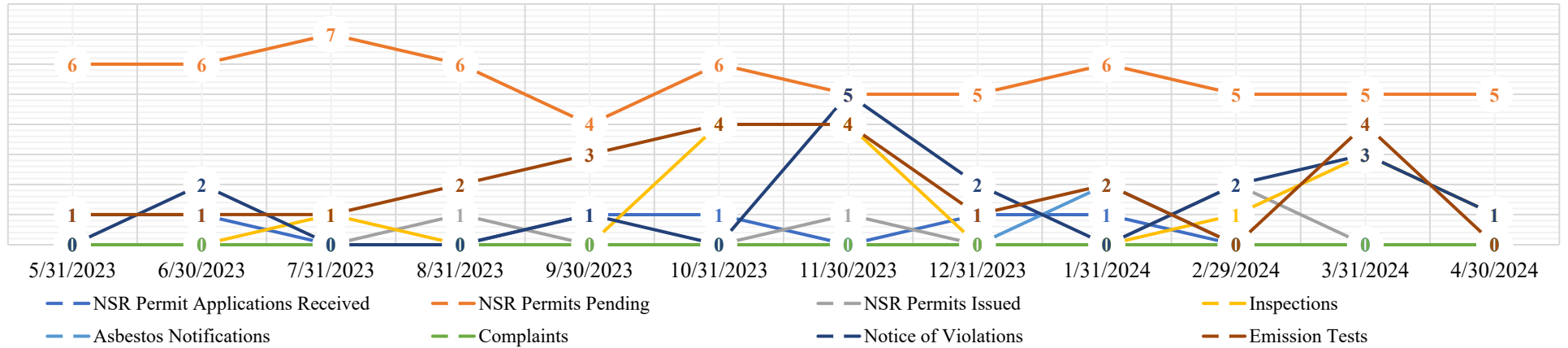


AMBIENT AIR MONITORING DATA



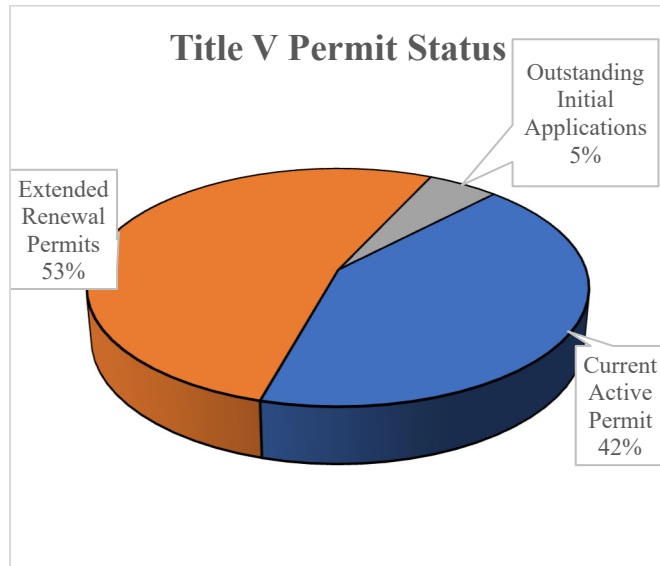
