








NON-TITLE V New Source Review - Permitting Actions





AMBIENT AIR MONITORING DATA


PM_{2.5} - rolling annual averages - μg/m³ [exluding flagged wildfire days] National Standard - 9 μg/m³ (3-year annual average)

Ozone (Vancouver) - Max 8-hour Averages - ppm


[National Standard: 0.070 ppm - 8 hour*]

*3-year average of the 4th highest values (latest 3-year avg. 0.059 ppm)




